Coach Code of Conduct

The following Codes of Conduct have been devised by Baljaffray FC and are based on the concept of fair play, defined by:

1. Respect for the rules
2. Respect for the match officials and their decisions
3. Respect for all participants, including team-mates, coaches and opponents
4. Maintaining self-control at all times

Baljaffray FC recommends the following guidelines on:

CLUB COACHES & OFFICIALS CONDUCT

Provide a positive environment for youths to play football - Be a role model to young players

Be a coach that players and parents respect by always setting a good example

Make it fun & challenging for young players, emphasising progress over perfection

Be patient and supportive to both players and parents

Place emphasis on good behaviour by players and parents

Exercise self-control when a goal is scored or conceded

Seek to update coaching skills and knowledge

Ensure players get equal instruction, coaching and support

Teach players to play fairly, respect themselves, the rules and opponents

Do not over-emphasise results

Never berate, ridicule or shout at players

Never address opposing teams' players or management in a negative or aggressive manner

Do not criticise, ridicule or show disrespect to match officials or speak to them in a negative or aggressive manner

Present a positive image on all social media platforms and posts and never use the posts to criticise a player, coach, opponent, parent or match official.
